## **Checklist - Non-EU Citizens**

1) Starting out Visit the ISM website ism.ku.dk to learn about important things such as the registration process in Denmark.
<b>2) Housing</b> It's a very good idea to begin searching for a place to live in Copenhagen in advance.
<b>3) Residence and work permit</b> Apply for your residence and work permit. ISM will initiate the process.
4) CPR number/health care When you arrive in Denmark, you must register for a CPR number. Your CPR number gives you access to health care among other things. Important: you need a legal address in Denmark in order to register and you need your CPR number for many other things in Denmark.
<b>5) Tax authorities</b> Register with the tax authorities. If you are eligible for the researcher taxation scheme, ISM can apply on your behalf.
6) Bank account When you have your CPR number, you can open a Danish bank account. Please contact ISM for more information
7) Good to go! ISM events are a great opportunity to meet other international staff and to receive information about working and living in Denmark. Check ism.ku.dk/events.
